## BALL MACHINE

The rental fee is \$ 10 per hour. Please call and reserve the machine 24 hours in advance.

## COURT ETIQUETTE AND DRESS CODE

- Members must wear proper sports clothing (No swimsuits!).
- Tennis shoes must have non-marking soles.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- No food or drinks allowed on courts
- Players waiting for a court must wait outside the playing area during lessons or other tennis activities.
- Members are asked to use the Southwest gate to enter courts for basketball or soccer.

**OUR TENNIS PROFESSIONALS**

**Amine Boustani (Director of Tennis and Fitness)**

In his second year at Millwood, Amine brings 20 years of teaching and coaching experience to the Millwood tennis program. He has taught at several world-class resorts and tennis academies such as Club Med, the Nick Bollettieri Tennis Academy and the Royal Tennis Club of Mohammedia. In 2006, Amine was honored as the National Coach of Year for the second time in his career by the NCAA. His teams at Drury University have reached the # 1 national ranking 4 times during his tenure at Drury. Amine is also the Head Coach of the Greater Springfield Community Olympic Development Program. He has coached several Professional, NCAA All-American and USTA nationally ranked players. A USPTR certified teaching Professional, Amine is one of a few who can teach the game of tennis in several languages (English, French, Spanish, and Arabic).

As a player, he has excelled as a junior reaching a career high world ranking of #32 and winning four national championships. In college, Amine won the NJCAA national championship and played # 1 for the Missouri State Bears. Upon graduation, Amine competed on the Professional Tour for one year before returning to Drury University and earning his Master's degree in Education.

**Jarrold Smith (Tennis Professional)**

Jarrold Smith is also in his second year at Millwood. The current Head Women's Coach at Drury University is one of the best NCAA coaches in women's tennis. His team is currently ranked # 10 nationally. Jarrold is a certified USPTA Professional and has taught at several clubs throughout the Midwest. Before arriving at Drury, Smith had spent the previous two seasons as an assistant for both the men's and women's programs at Northwest Missouri State University. The women's squad qualified for the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals each season. The Lee's Summit native was a standout player at NMSU as well, lettering all four seasons and earning six Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Associations championships (three in singles, three in doubles). He was a first-team all-MIAA selection each season from 2000-2003.

**Jeff Osborne (Tennis Professional)**

Jeff will return to Millwood as well this summer. A USPTR certified professional, Jeff has become one of the best High School tennis coaches in the area while coaching the Central High School boys and girls teams. Jeff also teaches at the Cooper tennis Complex in Springfield, Missouri.
